Two Magellanic **Penguin chicks** that hatched at the Aquarium of the Pacific in late June made their public debut on September 10, joining the rest of the penguins in the June Keyes Penguin Habitat. One chick is male and one chick is female.


The Tropical Reef Habitat, which can be viewed from three locations in the gallery, is the Aquarium's largest exhibit. Holding 350,000 gallons of water, this exhibit features over a thousand colorful fish and beautiful coral, including sea turtles, zebra and black tip reef sharks, porcupine puffers, and a large blue Napoleon or hump head wrasse.

Experts estimate that as much as 95 percent of the volume of the World Ocean and 99 percent of its seafloor remain unexplored.

Immerse yourself in our new special exhibit, ***Wonders of the Deep***. Visitors can see how mysterious sea creatures live beyond the reach of light, and discover the unusual and intricate ecosystems that have evolved within the deep ocean.


