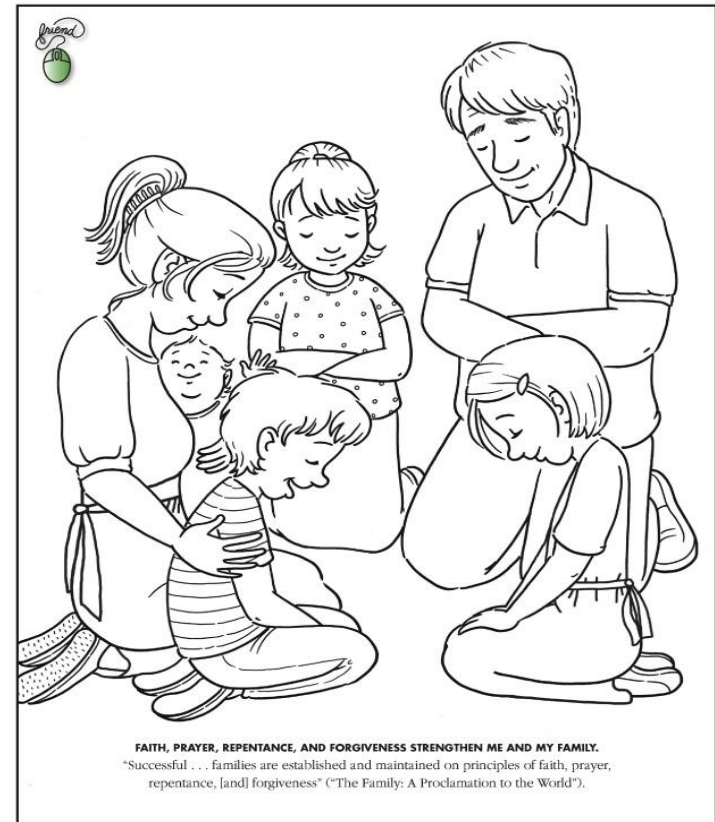
20. **PRAYER MINISTRY:** at 8:45 am each Sabbath morning a group will meet in the Minister's room behind the platform to pray.
