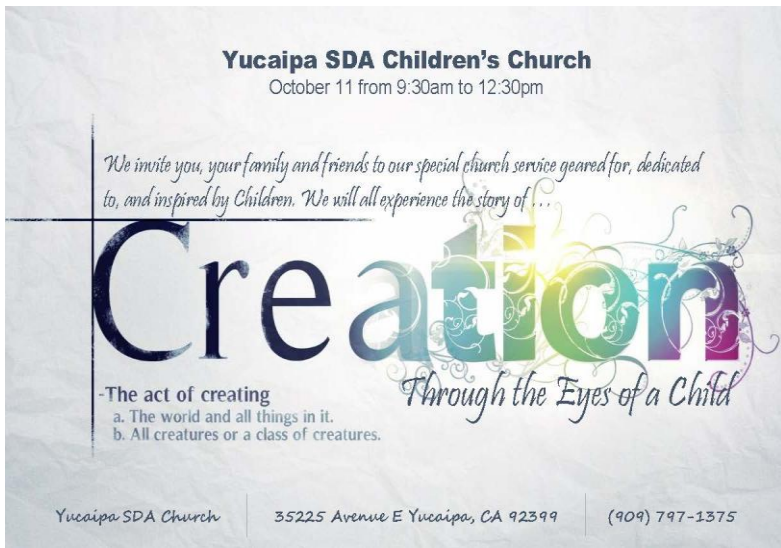

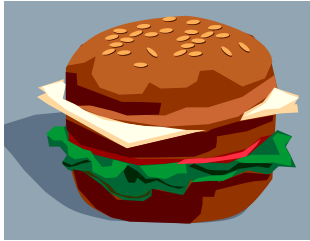

2. Turn RIGHT onto Oak Glen Road. After about three to four miles you will see a series of red apple signs on the left advertising the Parrish Ranch. Shortly after the signs, the road will fork.
3. Turn RIGHT onto Potato Canyon Road.
4. The house will be on the right about ½ mile up the road. It is just after the white fence.
5. Parking is up driveway between white fence and pink block wall.
