The first podcasts with the Seventh-day Adventist Message offered were in French; the number of subscribers for the spiritual programs is now 43,850, while the French health programs have grown to 89,100 subscribers. The next languages added were Italian, Amharic, and Kiswahili. Podcasts in Amharic — a language spoken primarily in North Central Ethiopia — currently has 11,530 subscribers, who live in countries as diverse as Canada, South Africa and the Netherlands.
