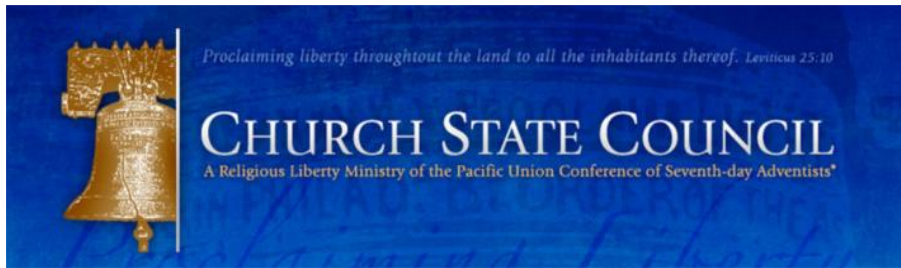

Legislative Update

AB 987 – Reasonable Accommodation

Existing law permits an employer to fire a worker for requesting accommodation, whether for a disability or for their religious observance, such as Sabbath. This bill clarifies that employee requests for accommodation are protected against retaliation. It has passed both chambers of the legislature, and is on its way to the Governor to sign or veto. SB 277- Vaccination Bill

Signed by the Governor on June 30.

Under this bill, if a parent chooses to not vaccinate their child, the parent would have to home-school their child, participate in a multifamily private home-school or use public school independent study that's administered by local education agencies, according to Pan and co-sponsor Sen. Ben Allen, former board president of the Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District.

SB 128 – Physician Assisted Suicide

SB 128 remains in the Assembly Health Committee and is not scheduled to be heard this year.

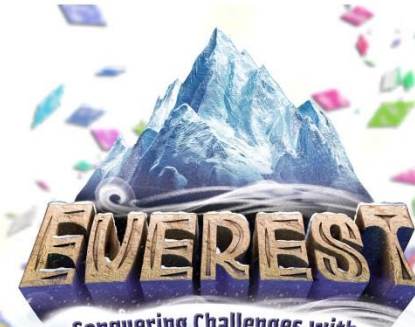
