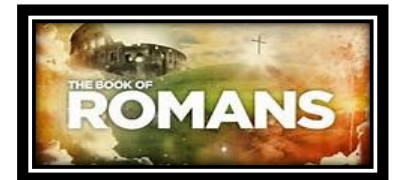

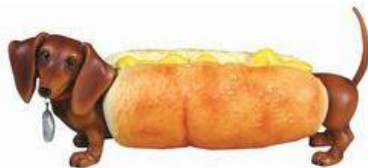
38387 Potato Canyon Road, Oak Glen

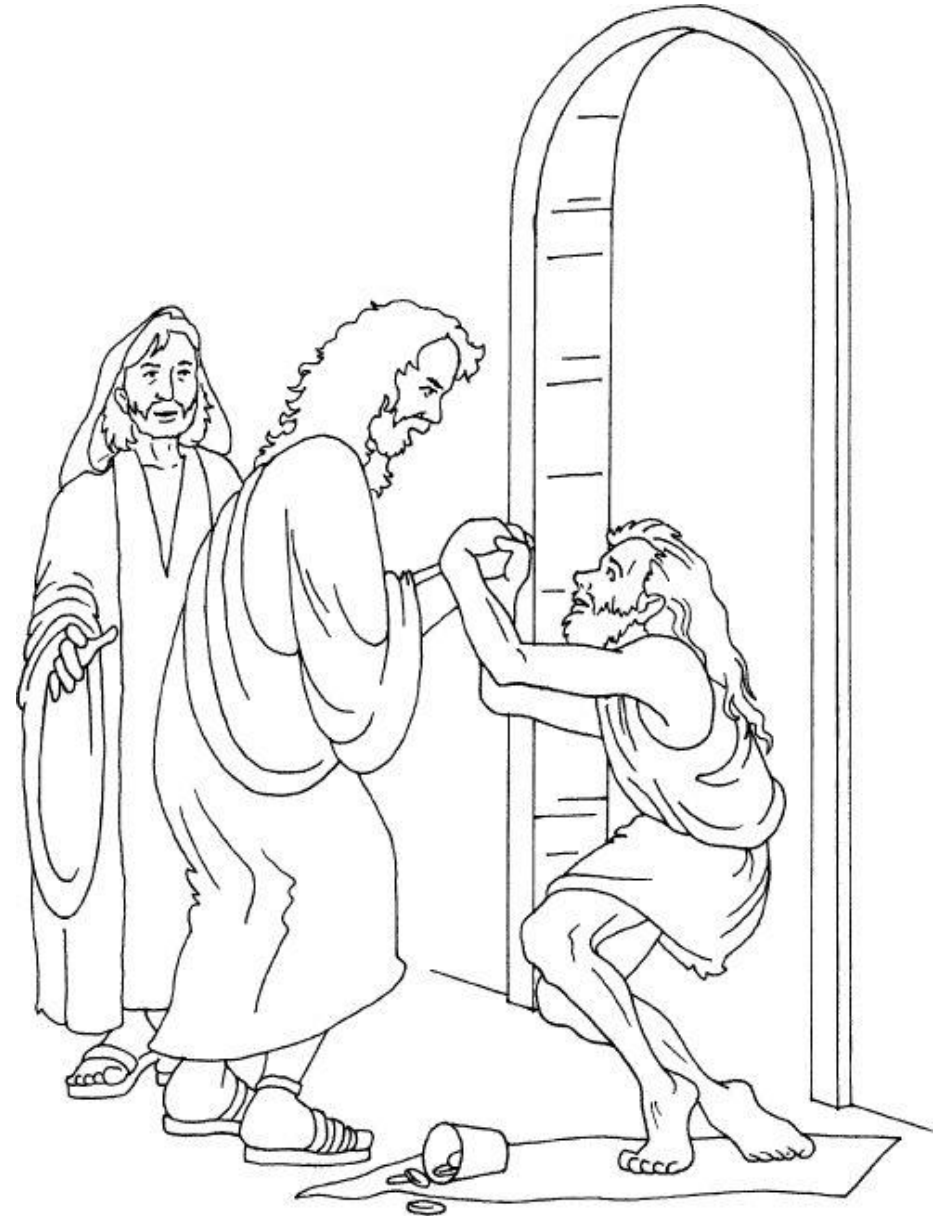
