That could be extremely disorienting to them, especially if they still believed that Jerusalem would be the capitol of the world. Now they must look to the heavenly sanctuary where their new High Priest was representing them. That's what Hebrews does.

The earthly sanctuary had two major apartments. How many does the heavenly sanctuary have? We will enter that debate.

What are the differences between the earthly and heavenly sanctuaries?

How many "rests" are there in Hebrews?

Can you be a priest in the heavenly sanctuary?
