

Hebrews is a letter to Jewish Christians. Only Jewish Christians could immediately grasp the import of what Paul was writing to them. The earthly sanctuary where they had gathered three times a year for fifteen hundred years would soon be destroyed. That could be extremely disorienting to them, especially if they still believed that Jerusalem would be the capitol of the world. Now they must look to the heavenly sanctuary where their new High Priest was representing them. That's what Hebrews does.

The earthly sanctuary had two major apartments. How many does the heavenly sanctuary have? We will enter that debate.

What are the differences between the earthly and heavenly sanctuaries?

How many "rests" are there in Hebrews?

Can you be a priest in the heavenly sanctuary?

We meet one hour before sunset in the sanctuary preceded by 15 minutes of live music. This is a refreshing way to close the Sabbath. If you have never attended, come and join us once and you will come again.

Sunset tonight is 6:52 p.m., so our study begins at 5:52 after the music.
